

INSTALLATION INSTRUCTIONS



Step #1

Remove the cover from the box with two able-bodied people. Transport the cover to the end of the pool where you normally enter and place on the bar top/shell, or deck surround.

Step #2

Find the large manila envelope inside the box. Set aside the hardware, keys, and registration card. Read the written installation instructions.



Step #3

After undoing the plastic wrap, roll the cover out across the entire shell or deck surround of the pool.

Note: Rolling the cover open and closed 3-4 additional times, will allow the cover to form and relax correctly.



Step #4

Simultaneously pull on the straps from both ends, stretching the cover. Next, walk around the entire perimeter of the pool, lifting up the skirt flap and ensuring that the cover is laying flat on the bar top or deck surround.

Step #5

Mounting female cover lock receivers. Start at one end, adjust and shorten straps lengths so the straps are tight at the fastening point. Position the female cover lock receivers to the cabinet or flush deck surround and mount using the supplied #4 hardware.

Note: Allow for seasonal adjustment in the strap length. Do not mount female receivers with the straps at full extension.

Step #6

Walk to the opposite side of the pool and pull the end straps taut, then repeat step #5 mounting female cover lock receivers. The internal frame should be completely domed, with a nice uniform arc.



Step #7

When rolling out your cover on top of the pool, please take notice that the cover frame [hoop rods] may be leaning one direction [left or right], or slightly off center. It is important to roll the cover against that lean a couple of times until the cover is predominantly center domed. Having the cover lean slightly to the left or the right on installation is not uncommon based on it being rolled up tight in a shipping container. 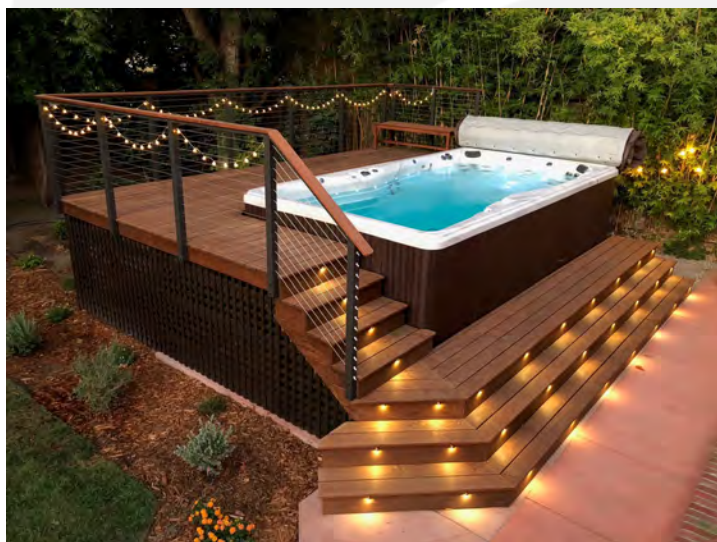
Step #8

Mounting the strap receivers on the long sides of the cabinet or deck surround. Do a final walk around the pool ensuring that the cover seal is created, laying flat on all sides. Finish mounting the remaining female cover lock receivers.



Step #9

Locking the cover and daily use. Every time you roll the cover closed, the end user should focus on pulling the end straps-taut, creating the center dome arc to a complete vertical position. Always fasten and lock the cover on all sides with key.



Step #10

*****Helpful tip for the end user:** The E2E Cover is designed to roll in both directions. Therefore, it is important to service the frame by rolling the cover in both directions on a consistent basis. Doing so, will help maintain the hoop rods in a vertical position the entire length of the cover, which will allow the cover to pitch rain off the exterior rain fly and maintain a proper heat seal on the underside. Adjust/shorten straps on all sides, so the straps are tight at fastening point to achieve a cover stretched to the final build length when fastening the cover taut and locking on all four sides.

Be sure to leave the cover in the closed position—ensuring the cover is latched down and locked on all sides—when your swim spa is not in use.
